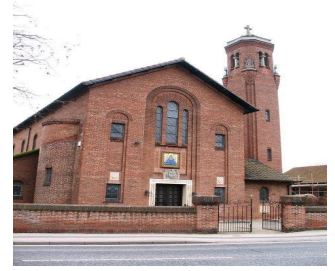

Annual Diocesan Missionary Appeal 13/14 Jan. THE COLUMBAN FAMILY

The Columban Fathers (founded Ireland, 1916) aim at inculturation of the Gospel in Cross Cultural environments. They engage in Reconciliation, Dialogue and building relationships between peoples of different faiths, cultures and ideologies.

The Columban Sisters (founded 1924) are in many of the countries where the Columban Fathers are and they minister together in a various ministries.

Columban Lay Missionaries minister with the Fathers and Sisters. They are mainly young single adults (some married couples) with a deep faith and a keen sense of mission. After a training period, they are contracted with the Columban Lay missionary Programme for a minimum of three years, which is renewable for a second term and again for a longer term of six years.

Columbans now have missions in China, Chile, Fiji, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Peru, Pakistan, the Philippines and Taiwan, UK, Ireland, Australia/ New Zealand and the USA, drawing members therefrom.

They enlist support through the pictorial family magazine **FAR EAST** with articles and features from the missionaries working at home and abroad with a circulation of about 75,000.
