DIOCESE OF MIDDLESBROUGH LOURDES PILGRIMAGE - 22nd - 29th May 2020

Appeal to all health care professionals in our diocese.
Could you spare one week of your annual holidays to come and work as a health care professional on our annual pilgrimage to Lourdes?

For more than 66 years, volunteers from across the diocese have assisted our pilgrimage by working with us to look after our supported pilgrims. Every year, we accompany and support over one hundred pilgrims with a variety of illnesses and disabilities to Lourdes. As a team, we look after their medical and care needs.

We welcome all health care professionals to join us. Currently we have doctors, nurses, as well as physiotherapy, pharmacy and emergency health care professionals, but all disciplines are welcome, especially health care assistants. In addition, nursing students who work as volunteers in Lourdes can include a reflection on this unique experience of holistic care as part of their educational portfolio.

Volunteers with a current health care professional registration are also needed to help with the pre-pilgrimage care needs assessments. This role might be ideal for people who wish to help with the work of the pilgrimage but are unable to travel for the week in Lourdes, whatever the reason.

Our Pilgrimage for 2020 commences on 22nd May and returns on 29th May
All volunteers are required to attend a Formation Event each year, and need to have a Diocesan Lourdes DBS certificate. The diocesan DBS team will arrange this for you. All volunteers travel and stay in Lourdes at their own expense.
