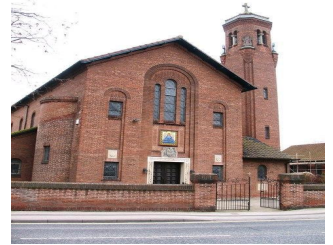

ENGLISH MARTYRS CHILDREN'S LITURGY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

English Martyrs children's liturgy teams of volunteers have helped enrich the faith of children in our parish for over 25 years. **However, this vitally important part of our ministry will only continue in the future if more volunteers come forward to help now.** Volunteers who have given many years of commitment, eventually need to stand down and must be replaced.

Volunteers prepare and deliver the Liturgy of the Word at the **10.30 am mass most Sunday mornings in the parish hall**, in a way which is accessible and meaningful to children of all ages. The Gospel is communicated through creative formats including drama, art, role play and discussion. Many of our current volunteers started without previous experience of work with children, yet now make a vital contribution. New volunteers may begin by observing sessions and helping to escort children over to the hall. Everyone can contribute their unique life experience, knowledge and talents. Volunteers help out on a rota, roughly every 4-6 weeks.

A warm welcome is offered to all of the children in our parish community including children who may be visiting. Children of school age may attend unaccompanied or with a parent/carer or older sibling if they wish, **but children who are not yet school age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.**

If you would like to find out more about how you can help, please talk to Lynda (01904 793921) or introduce yourself to one of our volunteers or Fr John. All prospective volunteers will be required to undertake a DBS check in line with the diocese safeguarding policy.

An impressive list of Course Leaders will assemble: Fr Damian Howard SJ is an expert on Christian-Muslim relations, Mr Gabriel Webber is a trainee rabbi, and Dr George Herring (focusing on John Henry Newman and Anglican-Catholic relations) is a Church historian.
