## CHILDREN'S LITURGY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

English Martyrs children's liturgy teams of volunteers have helped enrich the faith of children in our parish for over 25 years. **However, this vitally important part of our ministry will only continue in the future if more volunteers come forward to help now.** Volunteers who have given many years of commitment, eventually need to stand down and must be replaced.

Volunteers prepare and deliver the Liturgy of the Word at the **10.30 am mass most Sunday mornings in the parish hall**, in a way which is accessible and meaningful to children of all ages. The Gospel is communicated through creative formats including drama, art, role play and discussion. Many of our current volunteers started without previous experience of work with children, yet now make a vital contribution. New volunteers may begin by observing sessions and helping to escort children over to the hall. Everyone can contribute their unique life experience, knowledge and talents.

A warm welcome is offered to all of the children in our parish community including children who may be visiting. Children of school age may attend unaccompanied or with a parent/carer or older sibling if they wish, **although children who are not yet school age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.**
